Our Uniform

- Black smart trousers/skirt/shorts/culottes
- Plain white shirt/blouse/polo shirt
- Red sweatshirt or sweat cardigan (with school logo optional)
- Plain white/grey/black socks (long or short) or black tights
- Dark single colour shoes which are suitable for school (no high-heels)
- School red check summer dress may be worn in warmer weather

Year 6

- Black school v neck jumper (with school logo optional)
- White shirt or polo shirt and school tie (optional)

P.E. Kit

- Red t-shirt (with school logo optional)
- Navy or black shorts Navy or black plain tracksuit style trousers
- School jumper
- Trainers

Hair

- Should be neat and tidy and no distraction to learning.
- Long hair must be entirely tied back (so that it is off the face and neck) using a simple hair tie (blue, black, grey, or white). Please avoid large, colourful scrunchies or hair bands.

Jewellery

- Maximum of one pair of small stud earrings, which must be removed for P.E. (or taped over if the piercing is new)
- Watch
- No other jewellery
- No temporary tattoos, make-up or nail varnish should be worn

Outdoor Wear

- Children will need a warm / waterproof coat
- Children will need wellingtons to access the field and den-building areas at playtime in wet weather
